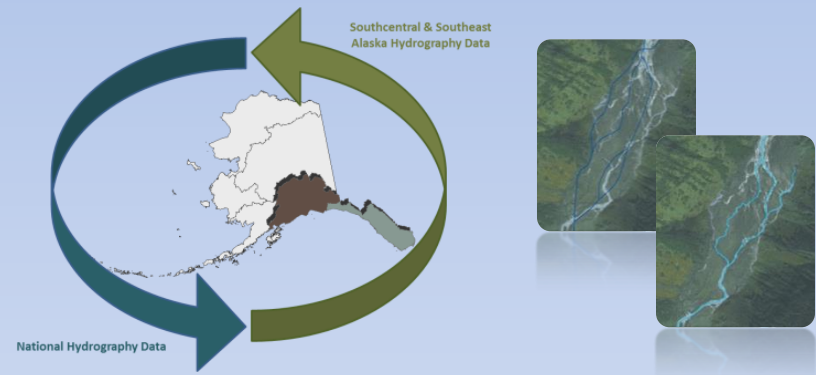

The remainder of the training will be focused on hands-on hydrography data processing and procedures in a computer lab setting.

 - Understanding of how to edit hydrographic data in a collaborative environment and submit updates
 - Knowledge on hydrography editing standards in Alaska
 - Understanding of AK Hydro data model standards
